

Victorian Curlers off to the Pacific Championships

Two Victorian Curlers are off to the Pacific Curling Championships in Uiseong, South Korea from November 16 - 23. Vaughan Rosier will be representing the Australian men's team and Bridget Becker will be representing the New Zealand Women's team. Both are regular Curlers at The Medibank Icehouse in Docklands.

This is Vaughan's first Pacific Championships. He will be playing with an experienced trio from Sydney; Hugh Millikin, Ian Palangio, John Theriault and fellow first timer Matthew Panoussi.

Bridget Becker is the skip of the New Zealand women's team and will be competing at her 12th Pacific Curling Championships. Bridget teamed up with her brother Sean to win the Silver medal at the 2010 World Mixed Doubles Curling Championships in Russia last April.

The Pacific Curling Championships are an annual event with teams competing from Australia, China, Chinese Taipei, Japan, South Korea & New Zealand. The top 2 teams from the Pacific Championships earn a berth at the World Curling Championships in Regina, Canada in April.
