

Australia takes Bronze at the Pacific's

The Australian men's curling team of Hugh Millikin, Ian Palangio, Matthew Panoussi and Vaughan Rosier, have won the Bronze medal at the Pacific Curling Championships in Uiseong, South Korea.

After a tough round robin competition the Aussies snuck into the finals with a 9-6 win over Chinese Taipei in an extra end. That left them with the daunting task of facing the undefeated Chinese team in the Semi-finals. Unfortunately that game went the way of China 8-2 which put Australia in the Bronze medal game against trans Tasman rivals New Zealand. After a tight battle, Australia pulled away in the 7th end with a deuce and followed that up with a score of 3 in the 9th end to wrap up the game and the Bronze medal.
